

DC Colts:

Welcome home! Most of us have been sharing photos with each other already via facebook, etc. I've created a Google Picasa web album that I wanted to share with you so that we can share high res photos with each other that can be used in the Colts memory album, and that you can personally print for your own scrapbooks (many of you are aware that the low resolution facebook pictures aren't ideal for print).

Please read the information below and let me know if you have any questions!

First, Google Picasa - It works similar to facebook where you can tag people in the images, BUT the photos stay hi-res instead of being resized. Plus you can add locations to the images as well. It's very user friendly.

To add your DC photos to the web album I've created, you can upload one of two ways:

1. Email them to colts.parade.photos@picasaweb.com with the word "Parade" in the subject line (no quotes). Please note since the images will be large files you should only send a few at a time. All these photos will show up in the same album. If you don't want to tag the photos this is the easiest way. (for those of you who might not know what "tag" is...you have the ability to label each person in your pictures - it's great!)

2. Login to Picasa web albums by going to: <http://picasaweb.google.com> with the username: colts.parade, password: coltsparade There you can go to the upload link on top, add the photo to an existing album or create a new one then upload 5 images at a time. Picasa will automatically recognize faces, so just tag a person by adding their name (and an email if you want).

If you know how to use facebook this should be pretty easy to figure out. Some of you may not use facebook, so please do not hesitate to let me know if you have any questions.

I encourage you to share as many photos as you can with the group!
